Thredbo is a typical European style Alpine village with every convenience for the tourist. The village has coffee lounges, restaurants, boutiques and a supermarket. It is surrounded by parks and streams. For the sporting enthusiast there are tennis courts a fully equipped A.I.S. gymnasium with an indoor swimming pool and a 9 hole golf course. It is only a short walk to the chair lift and the beginning of many leisurely walking trails from which you can enjoy the wildflowers.

The hub of village life is the Thredbo Alpine Resort where our bridge will be conducted. We have reserved all the downstairs rooms for our group members. You can upgrade to the Alpine Apartments next door if you prefer. The Welcome and Farewell dinners will be in the Resort's award winning Cascades Restaurant.

Holiday hosts, South Australian state bridge instructor David Lusk and former NSW state bridge instructor John Newman will conduct separate classes and workshops for open and for developing players. They will also conduct hand analysis of play sessions. Hands will be pre-dealt and hand records issued at the conclusion of play. Prizes will be presented to the top open and developers for all sessions and red points under the auspices of the NSWBA will be awarded for the Pairs, Teams and Swiss Pairs championships.

Welcome and Farewell buffet Dinners in Cascades Restaurant will again be included in your package.
